## Sun Screen Policy

The sun screen policy of Tomorrow's Stars Basketball Clinic is the following:

1. The staff will not apply sunscreen to campers. They will, however, encourage campers to use sunscreen. If a camper has a medical problem concerning the sun that is disclosed to the camp, then a staff member will help apply sunscreen to that camper. A letter from the camper's physician **MUST** accompany this request.
2. Parents are asked to apply sunscreen to their child in the morning, before they come to camp.
3. Parents are asked to send sunscreen with their child and show them how to apply properly
4. Campers generally will be encouraged to leave their shirts on during the day. Parents are asked to send children with appropriate clothing to accommodate various changes in weather. It is suggested that if a sweat shirt is worn to camp then a T-shirt must be brought to camp as well.
